TARGET GROUP

The target group will be the school of butalaale primary and the community around.

Project time period: One (1) year.

BACKGROUND:

Butalaale primary is based in mityana district, namugo sub county, uganda with a mission to offer education to the less privileged children in the rural parts of uganda and to offer support were we basically can.

The school chicken farm:

The chicken farm was started basically to improve the welfare of the children, the school and the community at large. This project was throughly revised to be one of the simpliest ways the school can do away with many of the healthy problems due to poor feeding and financial difficulties that restrict it from fulfilling some of it's goals. This chicken farm requires little space and relatively small initial capital per unit head compared to other livestock making it easy to venture into.

The first phase of the chicken farm project will target 500 chicken but with hope of reaching 5000 chicken birds in future prospective.

CURRENT SITUATION:

The school currently has atleast two spare acres of land and two unroofed large room from which this project can be operated. Since the chicken farm will require labour and intensive techniques there is a moderately good number of children that are eager to learn the work. This

will reduce on unexpected and unwanted costs.

THE GOALS OF BUTALAALE CHICKEN FARM

To improve on the diet of the children.

To develop the children's enterprenual skills that will be of much help in the future.

To train the village farmers income generating activities in order to generate enough money to support their families.

To set up a demonstration center where communities will meet to train and seek information.

To generate enough money that will help to meet most of our goals.

JUSTIFICATION OF THE PROJECT:

There is an increasing high demand of poultry meat, eggs not only in uganda but also in the greater lakes region because of the of the general improvement of standard of living of the people. Currently there is a lot of egg export from uganda to sudan, Rwanda and the Republic of Congo. Poultry is the most promising enterprise in the Ugandan livestock sector since it requires little space and relatively small capital per unit head compared to other livestock enterprise.

There is easy availability of day old chicken and feeds as well as chicken drugs on the market hence promoting chicken farming.

MANAGEMENT:

For any project to succeed, proper and efficient management is essential in order to realize good returns on investments. Poultry labour intensive approach will be employed for maximum production which will include both the school kids and the village farmers later in the future.
